Fast and efficient transport links with the EU

Rail Corridor X is part of the indicative extension of the Orient/East-Med Corridor into the region, connecting Central Europe and the Western Balkans with the maritime interfaces of the North, Baltic, Black and Mediterranean Seas. The Corridor fosters the development of those ports as major multimodal logistic platforms, improving the connections of key economic centres in Central Europe to the coastlines and Cyprus.

The WBIF investments in rail systems in the region support multimodal solutions to shift as much cargo as possible from roads to rail, and ensure the better use of inland waterways and maritime transport. These will boost business, make the air cleaner and roads safer.
