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- **Energy Markets** – 3rd Energy Package adopted in October 2011
- **Competition** – the Treaty (2006)
- **Renewable Energy** – Directive 2009/28/EC as adapted and adopted in October 2012
- **Environment** – last updated in 2016
- **Security of Energy Supplies** – adopted in 2008
- **Energy Efficiency** – adopted in October 2009, 2010
- **Energy Statistics** – adopted in October 2012
- **Oil** – adopted in October 2012



- **3rd Energy Package** - *Common Rules for the Internal Market in Electricity* - deadline for implementation in EnC – 1 January 2015
 - Ownership Unbundling for the TSO
 - Call for tenders and granting authorisation for generation capacities
 - Third Party Access
 - Operation of the electricity system
 - Enhance independence for the National Regulators
 - Retail markets

Overview of RE Directive 2009/28/EC

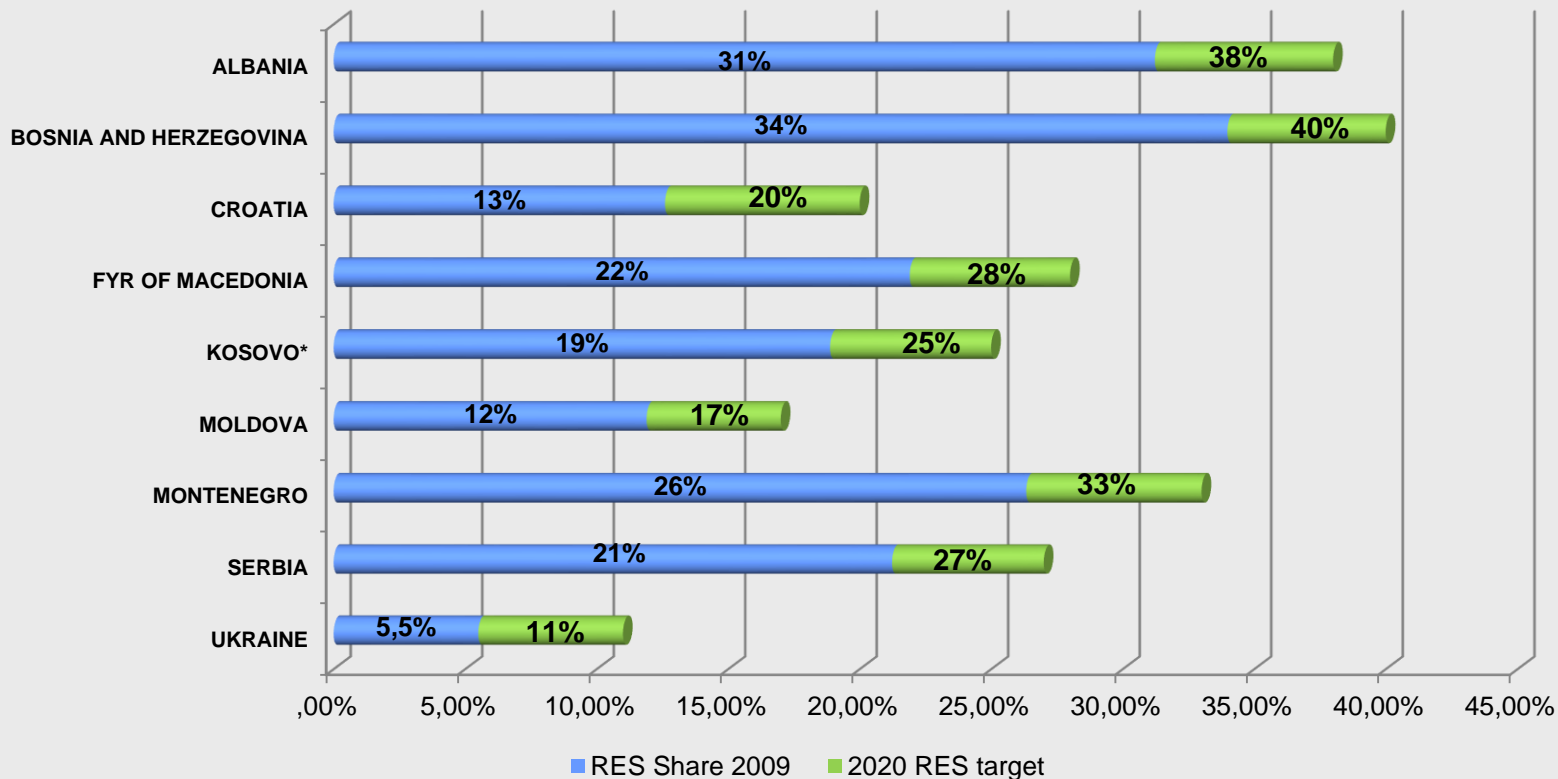


1. *Mandatory national targets

6. *Sustainability regime for biofuels*



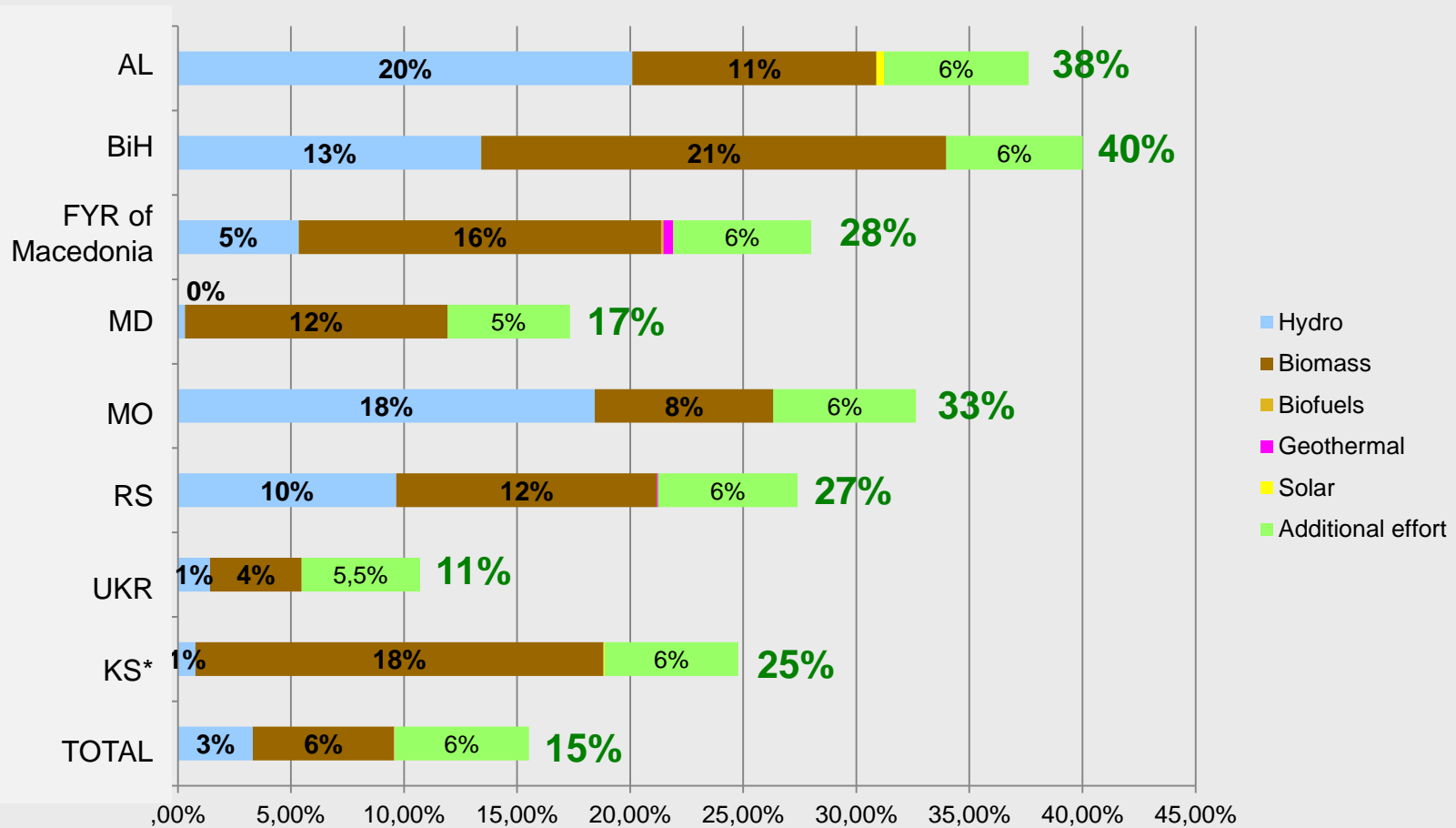
- ❖ *Adapted and included in the energy acquis - Article 20 of the Treaty establishing the Energy Community – October 2012*
- ❖ *Deadline for implementation - 1 January 2014*
- ❖ *Mandatory overall targets to 2020, 10% RES in transport*
 - *Indicative trajectories to 2020*
 - *Indicative per sector: RES-E, RES-H*
 - *Binding for RES-T*
- ❖ *Deadline for submission of NREAP – 30 June 2013*
- ❖ *Progress Reports every two years (2014, 2016, 2018, 2020)*

2020 RES Targets

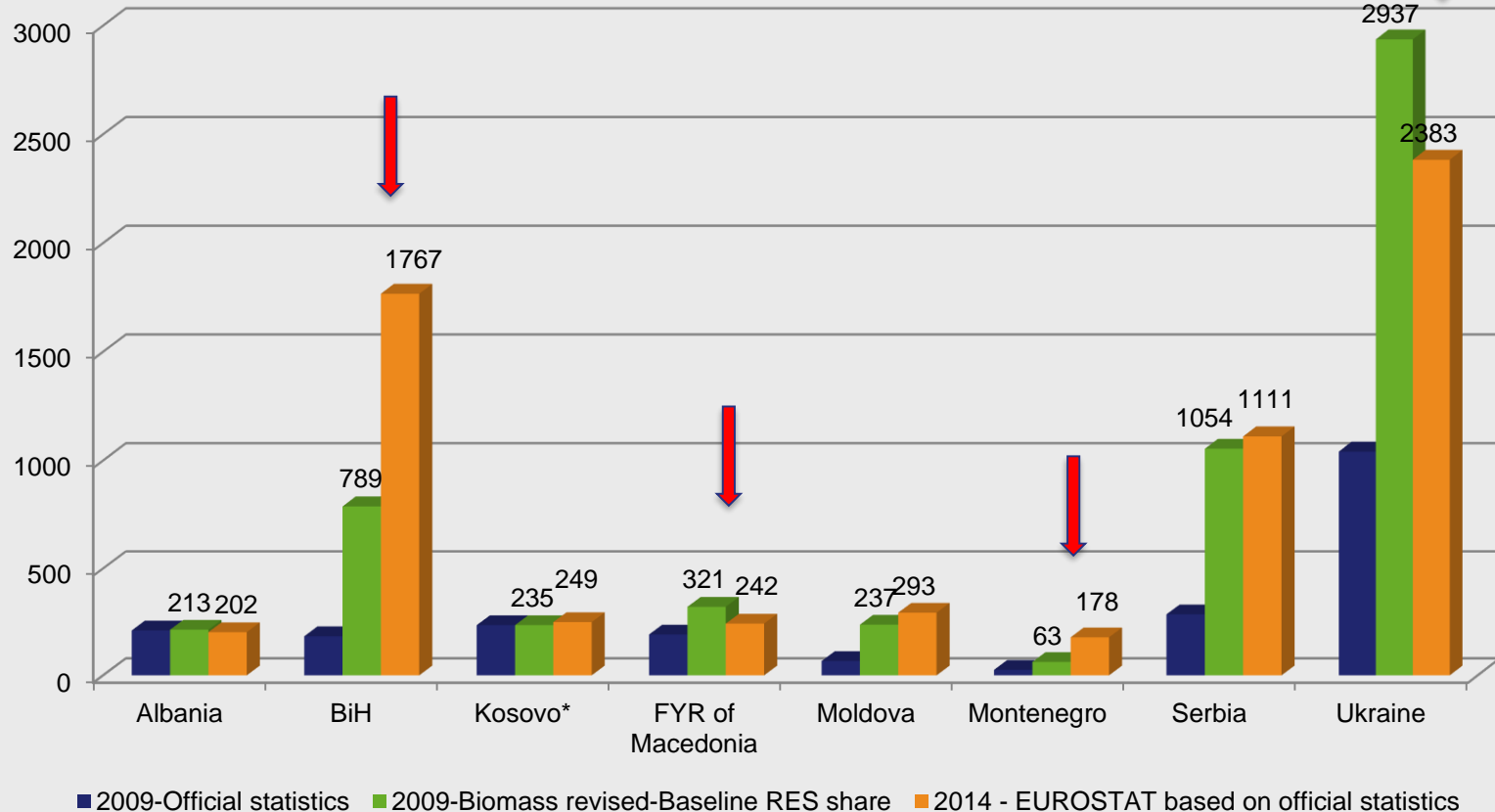

2020 RES Targets – revised 2009 biomass data



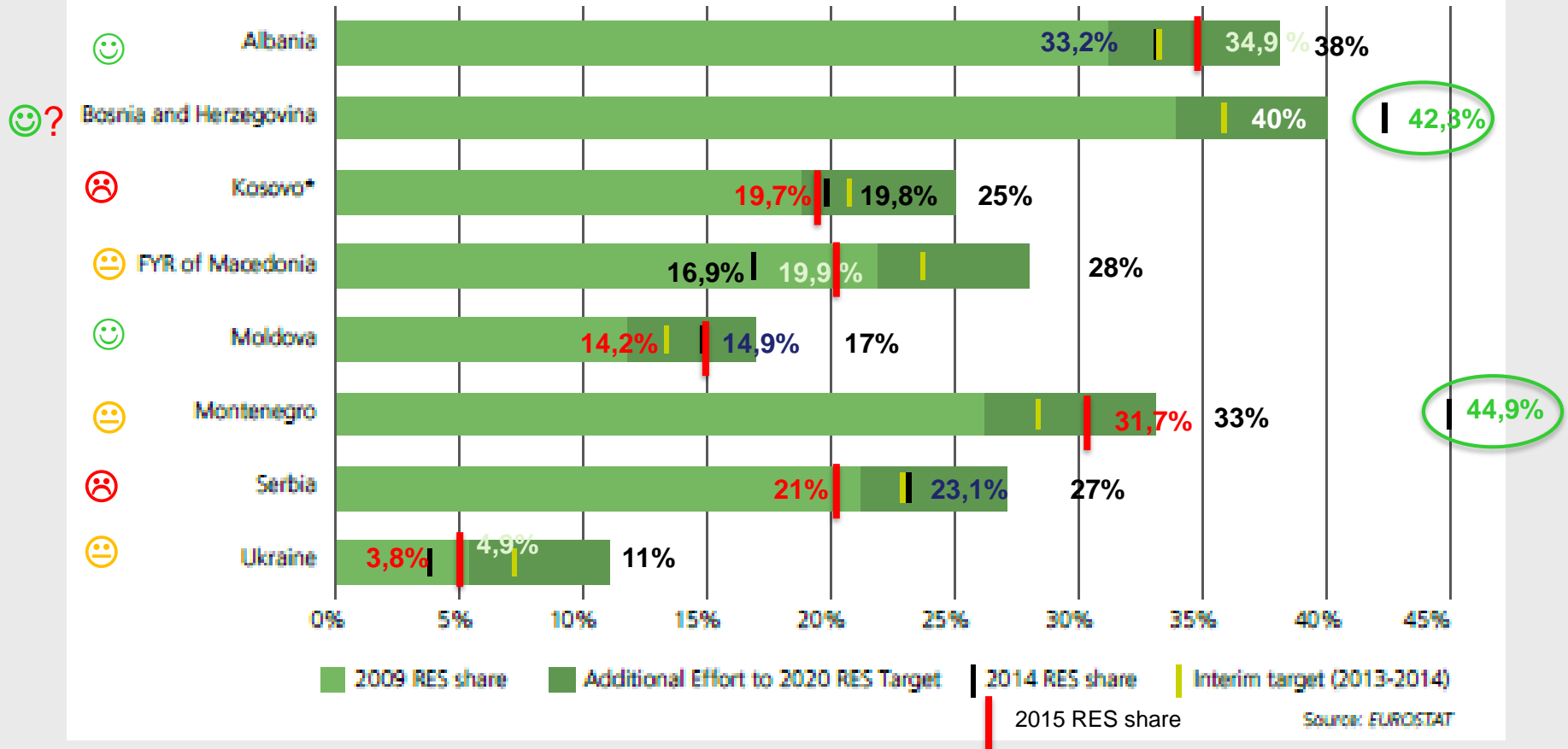
Biomass data – reliability of energy statistics continue to improve impacting the RES objectives to 2020

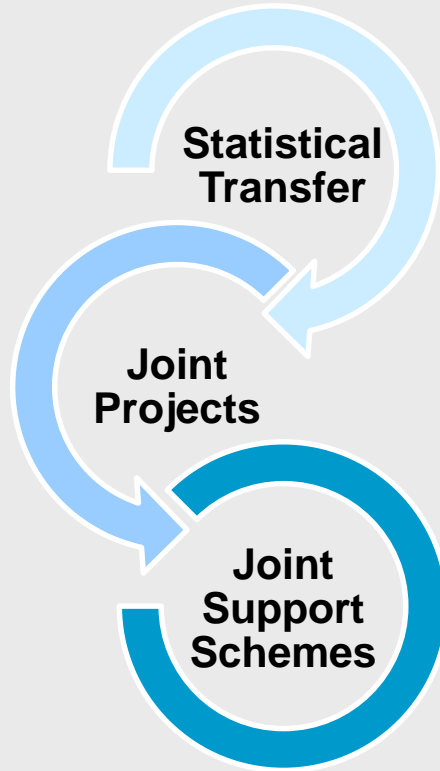


Progress in the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources – Second Progress Reports



Energy Community Renewable Energy 2020 Targets





- *Contracting Parties are free to choose sectors to develop RES*
- *No technology-specific requirements*
- *Statistical transfers*
- *Joint projects between Contracting Parties, with EU Member States and with countries outside EU*

Art 16 – Access to and operation of the grids



- **Priority or guaranteed access for RES-E producers to TSOs and DSOs**
 - *Priority in dispatching the RES-E generation units »»» without endanger the reliability and security of the grids*
- **Obligations for TSOs and DSOs**
 - *develop infrastructure to accommodate electricity from renewable energy sources*
 - *require TSOs and DSOs to publish technical rules and connection tariffs*
 - *accelerate authorisation procedures and coordinate with administrative and planning procedures*
 - *could require TSO and DSO to bear the costs of connection*
 - *adopt non-discriminatory charges for use of TSO and DSO networks*
- **Access to and operation of the networks - monitored by NRA**
