



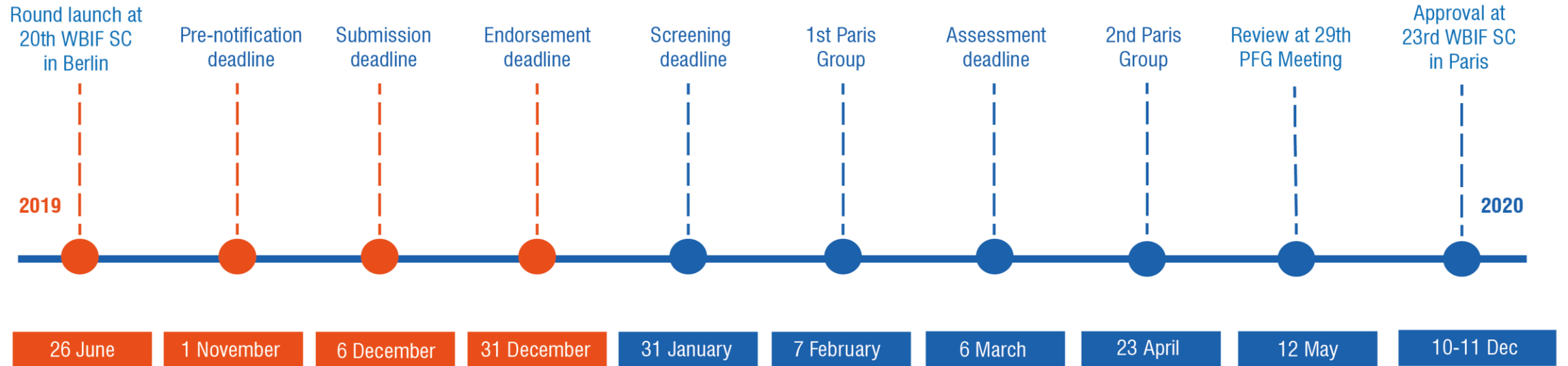

Timeline



Endorsement **3 weeks** 09/12/19 - 31/12/19

Screening **4 weeks** 06/01/20 - 31/01/20

Assessment **4 weeks** 10/02/20 - 06/03/20



Eligibility criteria

- Eligible sectors: ENE, ENV, SOC, TRA
- All sectors: National sector strategies in place & project proposals prioritised and identified in the SPPs;
- Energy projects must demonstrate a regional impact with the exception of smart grids/meters;
- Transport projects must be part of the Core Network as defined under the Indicative Extension of the TEN-T Network to the Western Balkans.
- Only Core airports/ports are eligible.
