# Components of the NIC Framework

## *Three mandatory criteria of the NIC Framework*

- *Ownership: to be demonstrated by the involvement / signing off of projects by the MoF and PM Office/Council of Ministers;*
- *Prioritisation: of projects and distinction of mature and not mature leading to a single list of prioritised projects ready for submission, based on objective criteria (followed by ownership);*
- *Transparency: to be demonstrated by the structured processing of projects through the project pipelines; which national key stakeholders are involved.*



# NIC Framework Activities and stakeholder engagement

- WBIF / IFICO NIC Framework TA01
  - NIC Framework Needs Assessment site visits to WBIF Beneficiaries - July 2014;
  - NIC Needs Assessment Report – September 2014 (updating ongoing).
- WBIF / IFICO NIC Framework TA02
  - Comprehensive site visits;
  - Analysis of NIC Principles (Ownership, Prioritisation, Transparency);
  - Development of Action Plans.



# Drafting and implementation of NIC Framework Action Plans

WBIF / IFICO TA02

- Further, more detailed analysis;
- Joint development of draft Action Plans;
- These Action Plans address the shortfalls to the mandatory NIC framework requirements;
- Action Plans aim at NIC Framework compliance by July 2015 (BiH maybe longer);
- IFICO will monitor and support the implementation of the Action Plans.
