## Modernisation of Judiciary Facilities: Procurement Support for the Prosecutor's Office and the Palace of Justice

Serbia has embarked on a comprehensive programme for the upgrade and reconstruction of priority judiciary buildings and facilities across the country, as part of the National Judicial Reform Strategy. The programme facilitates the country's EU integration and accession. This project concerns: (i) refurbishment of the Justice Palace of the Belgrade District Court (the Higher Court), (ii) rehabilitation and reconstruction of facilities that belonged to the Military Technical Institute at 15 Kataniceva Street in order to house the Prosecutor's Office, and (iii) construction of a new wing for the Special Court located in Ustanicka Street.

This grant covers the preparation of tender dossiers and assistance to the beneficiary/partner with the procurement process for the Prosecutor's Office in (Kataniceva Street Building) and the Palace of Justice (Building B).

The rehabilitation of the Prosecutor's Office in Belgrade is now complete, and the new premises have been commissioned. Works are currently ongoing on the other components, with WBIF/EU grant assistance for the supervision services.
