Kostolac Wind Farm

The European Commission supports the Western Balkans partners in their transition to low-carbon economies.

This flagship investment of the Economic and Investment Plan will install and connect to the electricity grid a 66 MW wind farm in Kostolac, eastern Serbia, on the site of depleted open-cast mines.
