EU and EBRD to finance road section from Skopje to the Kosovo* border

The EU and the EBRD are financing a new motorway section in North Macedonia. An EU investment grant of €20.8 million, as well as €8.8 million in funding for technical cooperation will be complemented by a €167.6 million loan from the EBRD to construct the motorway.
